The Gudang Garam Mess was built to accommodate visiting staff from outside Jakarta.

The landscape design for this small apartment block reflects the strong geometric patterns of the West Javan tobacco plantations on which PT. Gudang Garam depends. The sequence of small gardens, courtyards, walkways and terraces are designed to provide places to rest, talk, meet and reflect, which complement activities in the adjacent office. Timber boardwalk bridges across the 'agricultural grid' of water, lawn, seating walls and trees connect the apartments with the principal Gudang Garam office complex so that the visiting employees who stay in the apartments can relax and enjoy a secluded, shady retreat as they move between workplace and accommodation. This is a corporate landscape with a homey touch. Intimate, meticulous detailing strikes the balance between formality and comfort and a lush tropical garden room on the rooftop provides a luxury hideaway from the office routine.
